After a hiatus of 2 years our team returned to Guyana in August for a Character Skills Training

Workshop. The five-day Workshop held at St Stanislaus College, Brickdam, Georgetown attracted 225 students and 45 educators from 6 schools: Jo'Sel Education Institute, Providence Primary, Meten-Meer-Zorg Islamic Academy, Stella Maris, St. Margaret's Primary, Malgre Toute Primary. Justice Corp and a group of 45 children and teenagers from underserved communities also attended.

The children showcased their understanding of the Six Pillars of Character on the final day of the workshop with entertaining and informative characterizations of the Pillars. The Chief Education Office Dr. Marcel Hutson and Director of the Diaspora Affaris Unit in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Ms. Rosalinda Rasul attended the Friday celebration, as well as representatives of the media, parents and guardians of the children.


